1 Between lines 131812 and 131813, insert:

2 **"Section 323.\_\_\_\_\_.** PROPOSAL TO REFORM MEDICAID AND OHIO'S  
3 HEALTH CARE DELIVERY SYSTEM

4 (A) Legislation shall be introduced in the House of  
5 Representatives to reform the Medicaid program and Ohio's health  
6 care delivery system. The Director of the Governor's Office of  
7 Health Transformation and the Medicaid Director shall provide  
8 assistance in developing the legislation. The legislation shall  
9 include, but not be limited to, all of the following:

10 (1) A focus on individuals who have the greatest potential  
11 to obtain the income and resources that would enable them to  
12 cease enrollment in Medicaid and instead obtain health care  
13 coverage through employer-sponsored health insurance or the  
14 health insurance marketplace;

15 (2) Strategies to lower Medicaid caseloads by promoting  
16 employment-related services available under Medicaid, including  
17 Medicaid managed care, and promoting other programs that offer  
18 workforce readiness, educational, and wellness services;

19 (3) Provisions that seek to do both of the following:

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20 (a) Lower net state and federal costs for the Medicaid  
21 program;

22 (b) Reduce the number of individuals who enroll in Medicaid  
23 over time.

24 (B) The legislation may call for amending the state  
25 Medicaid plan, obtaining a waiver under the "Social Security  
26 Act," section 1115, 42 U.S.C. 1315, or a combination of the two.  
27 Subject to division (c) of this section, the Medicaid Director  
28 may submit to the United States Department of Health and Human  
29 Services a state Medicaid plan amendment, a request for a  
30 section 1115 waiver, or a combination of the two.

31 (C) Not sooner than September 15, 2013, and not later than  
32 October 1, 2013, the Directors shall submit to the General  
33 Assembly the terms of any federal approval obtained for the  
34 reform. The Directors shall not begin implementation of the  
35 reform unless the General Assembly enacts legislation  
36 authorizing implementation. If the General Assembly does not  
37 enact such legislation on or before December 31, 2013, the  
38 Directors shall cease any activity regarding this reform,  
39 including pursuing a Medicaid plan amendment, section 1115  
40 waiver, or combination of the two."
